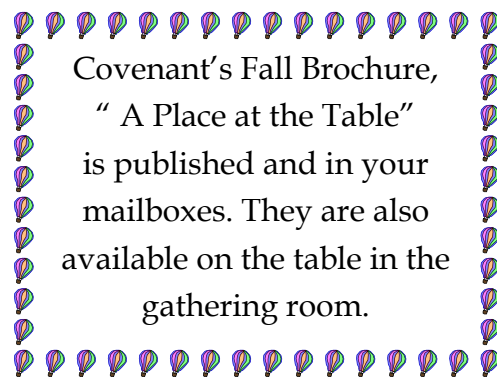


Retirees of all ages & stages enjoy active fellowship & renewing friendships. Join us on

The Session-designated early childhood playground design committee believes these optional additions will strengthen the presence as well as effective use of this new facility and its immediate surroundings. Please consider making a contribution.

Benches, 1 to 3, to place inside playground fencing for use by supervising adults

Mulch, 2 cubic foot bags, up to 40, for spreading outside the fence to prevent adjacent areas from turning to mud after rains

Square step stones, 16" gray, 17 for widening the breezeway sidewalk out to the new backyard steps

Portland pavers, 60, to extend walkway from stairs out of the WoRM building to playground

Landscape shrubbery, in 1 - 5 gallon containers, compatible with shade garden growth and blooming

Daffodil bulbs, to plant for blossoming with each new Spring

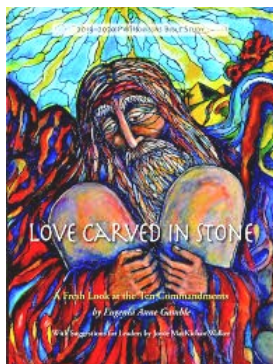
