
#### Peace & Global Witness

## Highlights of Called Session Meeting on September 11, 2022

Rev. Dana Waters opened the meeting with prayer and a devotion on resolving issues faithfully using Matthew 18:15-20 as a guide. Jesus encourages us to talk with one another in a spirit of mutual humility and persist in love, even in challenging situations.

The purpose of the called meeting was to discuss Covenant's policy of allowing unhoused overnight guests on church property. An opportunity was given for the Session members to share their views as well as views from the congregation that they had heard from on this issue.

There was a segment for the Session to:

- 1. Clarify the issue and to define it.
- 2. Set goals on how to address the issue.
- 3. To establish a process and a timeline to meet the goal.

There was an information sharing time where the Session heard from several Session members of what they learned from other local churches who also face some of the same issues as Covenant.

Some Session members volunteered to gather facts to share at the next meeting related to the number of volunteer hours needed to keep the campus cleaned up, how many people are receiving shelter, and other information and resources available in the community.

The next called meeting to continue this conversation will be Tuesday, Oct. 4th at 7:00 pm.


