Forming a Nominating Committee for the Election of Elders



#### Highlights of the June 27 Session Meeting

Clayton Adams read a devotional that included an invitation to *Pause* (and breathe), *Listen* (read Luke 6:22-23), *Think* (contemplate being hated for doing what you know is right and how Christ experienced this), *Pray* (ask God to guide our actions and help us act out of love), and *Go* (spread the word).

Kathryn Fowler reported that the Finance Ministry Team is working on developing financial policies, looking at what Covenant currently does and what policies other churches use. They are pulling together a working group to continue this process.

The Session has called for a Congregational Meeting on Sunday, July 16, after worship for the purpose of electing the third member of the Nominating Committee to decide next class of elders. The Session approved a motion to amend Rev. Dana Waters' interim contract to reflect the salary/housing allowance in the 2023/24 budget. Linda Koehler and Clayton agreed to serve as commissioners to August 26 Presbytery meeting.

Dick Zimdars introduced a discussion about solar panels and a fundraiser concert to dedicate the digital grand piano purchased in the summer of 2020. The Session commissioned the Building & Grounds Committee to further research the solar panel project with updated estimates and information about government support, asking them to present their findings to the Session by the end of October.

Dana shared a document with four weeks of tentative paternity leave dates and a list of guest preachers as well as pastors on call. He explained this fell within the new PC(USA) policy giving twelve weeks of paid family leave. The Session encouraged Dana to take the time he needs to help his family and agreed to readily revisit the schedule should Dana wish for more time.

Dana noted that one summer Session meeting is traditionally a social gathering to build fellowship. Usually the July meeting (July 25) is a social time, but Dana suggested that this be swapped with August 22 since his paternity leave will likely start before the August date. After discussion it was decided that the next Stated Session Meeting will be on July 25. The Session meeting in August will be social.

Kathryn Fowler shared that the PNC received training in May from the Presbytery. They decided on co-chairs – Linda Rogers and Karen Foutz. The Mission Discernment Profile is now underway and this is the "public face" the church puts out to those who will apply. They are also trying to think ahead with their budget to make sure their needs are covered.

Bert Ballard-Myer shared information about the Athens Pride Parade on June 3. They sold 54 tee shirts and had over 30 people participating. Valerie gave an update on the Olomouc ministry and the Church Partnership Network conference that will be held July 9-14 at our sister church in the Czech Republic. Valerie, her son Eli, and Joan Prittie will represent Covenant.
