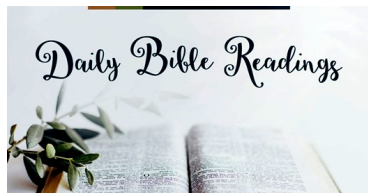

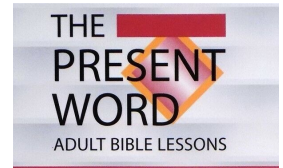


CHRISTIAN EDUCATION CLASSES FOR ALL AGES!

The Session has reviewed our service to our children and nursery care and found the need to hire a childcare provider to support our Sunday services, special services as needed, and Wednesday night events. We are thrilled at this growth because it means we are seeing more children in our Church and this is part of our Mission/Vision to grow our younger families as Members of the church.

The Christian Education Committee will be posting a job description for the Childcare position and will be starting interviews as soon as they find interested candidates. Be assured we are following our childcare policies and all background checks will be completed. We also keep to our policy where there will always be two unrelated adults with our children, so even with a professional caregiver, we will still require at least one Volunteer to keep our nursery running smoothly. When the Christian Education Committee has a recommendation for hire, it will go through the Session for a final vote of approval. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023!

The 2022-2023 fiscal year ended on June 30, 2023. Here is a summary of income and expenses for the year. Income was received from the following sources: Pledges \$415,326.60 (anticipated \$385,440.00), non-pledged income \$25,072.19 (budgeted \$13,997.00), other income including rent \$3,013.00 (budgeted \$3,000) for a total of \$443,411.79 compared to an original budgeted amount from all sources of \$402,437.00. The non-pledged income includes a number of late pledges that were made after the budget was finalized. This means the income surpassed the budget by \$40,974.79.

Actual expenses for the 2022-2023 fiscal year totaled \$374,853.36. The amount budgeted was \$423,549.99, leading to a net balance of \$48,696.63 in budgeted funds not spent. Note that this budgeted amount is different than the original budget listed in the paragraph above because Session voted to add additional money to the budget for hiring an accompanist and music director due to difficulty filling the positions. A detailed list of expenditures was provided to Session for the ministry team heads in the July Session packet. Karen can provide copies if needed. The biggest portion of the budget that was not spent was money for the Music Director and Piano Accompanist positions, which were filled for only part of the fiscal year.

The net amount of actual income minus actual expenses was \$68,558.43 (\$443,411.79-\$374,853.36). In 2023-2024, \$12,000 of this money will be used to fund the Capital Reserve line that was the only thing removed from the 2023-2024 budget to match the pledges for 2023-2024. The remainder of unspent funds will be placed in the general fund of the church to be used for future needs as designated by the Session.

Thanks to all of our Covenant family for faithfully fulfilling their pledges as well as supporting the church in so many other ways!
