Greetings from Durham! In mid-August, I returned from a three-month-

long stay in Yei, a small, rural town in South Sudan, Africa. From May to August, I taught at Bishop Allison Theological College, a struggling seminary hoping to train Christian leaders to serve the Sudanese people. During my time in Yei, I taught, preached, and explored methods and strategies for community development that, I hope, will influence the school's trajectory and mission—my time at Covenant proved incredibly helpful, providing me with a wealth of experiences to pull from while teaching and serving this small, rural town.

In the same way that God has blessed Athens with Covenant, I hope to share how God is blessing the people of South Sudan, even in the face of tremendous instability and violence. Please join me on Sunday, October 15th, to discuss the massive need for Christian missions and ministry in South Sudan and East Africa. I pray we have a room overflowing with questions, comments, and lively conversation!
