In mid-August, I returned from a three-month-long stay in Yei, a small, rural town in South Sudan, Africa. From May to August, I taught at Bishop Allison Theological College, a struggling seminary hoping to train Christian leaders to serve the Sudanese people. During my time in Yei, I taught, preached, and explored methods and strategies for community development that, I hope, will influence the school's trajectory and mission—my time at Covenant proved incredibly helpful, providing me with a wealth of experiences to pull from while teaching and serving this small, rural town.

In the same way that God has blessed Athens with Covenant, I hope to share how God is blessing the people of South Sudan, even in the face of tremendous instability and violence. Please join me on Sunday, October 15th, to discuss the massive need for Christian missions and ministry in South Sudan and East Africa. 


# CHRISTIAN EDUCATION CLASSES FOR ALL AGES!

Is there someone you can invite over for coffee or to come along on a stroll? If you regularly get together with other Covenant folks for a meal or outing, are there others who might enjoy an invite? Sometimes we gravitate to others our age or who have kids/grandkids in the same stage of life as ours, but maybe there are new friendships we haven't stopped to consider. Widening our circles brightens the lives of others...and our own lives too.

## Highlights of the September 26, 2023 Stated Session Meeting

Linda Koehler opened the meeting with prayer and a devotional comparing life to quilts and quilting. Both are wholes made up of varying good and bad pieces and require forgiveness for imperfections. We all make mistakes, but God forgives us repeatedly and asks us to participate in forgiveness.

Luanne Rigsby, Clerk, reported that our membership totals 206 following Dan Stoneburner's passing.

A motion by Kathryn Fowler, Finance Ministry Team, to allocate \$12,000 from \$68,558.43 in surplus funds from the 2022-2023 budget to the Long Term Maintenance Fund, thereby restoring the amount that had been cut from Capital Reserves in the original budget, was passed.

Dana spoke with Session about making plans for elders rotating off at the end of the year. A motion to lower the quorum from 7 to 4 for meetings specifically called to receive new members passed. Linda Koehler gave a report on the NEGA Presbytery Zoom meeting held on August 26, 2023.

Kathryn Fowler reported that the Pastor Nominating Committee is meeting weekly. They are in the midst of writing the summaries on who we are, our history and growth as a church, where we want to be going and what we are looking for in our next pastor based on the Holy Cow (CAT) Survey and work already done by the Mission Study Task Force. They hope to provide a final draft of the document to the Session for approval by November 21<sup>st</sup>. Next it will go to the NEGA Presbytery Committee on Ministry for its vote of approval. Then it will go online. The PNC will begin to receive applicants and start the review process.

Bert Ballard-Myer reported that Mission Outreach Ministry Team and Amy Baer have been busy with the following projects:

**Legal Aid Pop-up Clinic** - Covenant will be providing space and volunteers to help with a pop-up clinic held by The Athens Access to Legal Justice organization. They will offer free legal advice to those in need similar to the medical pop-up clinic.

**Holiday Benevolence Market** - Covenant will be hosting this "market" which was first begun by First Presbyterian Church. Different local aid organizations, i.e., Habitat for Humanity, The Ark, Project Safe, etc., will have booths where attendees can donate money. Covenant will provide space, tables and chairs, and volunteers.

**AmeriCorps Food Fellows Partnership** - AmeriCorps volunteers, who are focused on food insecurity, will be volunteering in our food pantry.

Valerie Stone gave the Session an interesting and inspiring report on the Church Partnership Conference that Eli, Joan Prittie and she attended in Olomouc last July.

Abby Horvath shared that Personnel and Dana will be checking in with staff in the coming weeks.
