

Highlights of the December 5, 2023, Stated Session Meeting

Kathryn Fowler presented a devotional based on Advent Book – On the Way to Bethlehem (put together with Czech Rep church friends) emphasizing "let your gentleness be apparent to all" and opened the meeting with prayer.

The Session gave approval for non-Session members to speak during the meeting.

Dana shared that he will have a hybrid work from home schedule in the next week or 2 as he helps his family as his mother approaches the end of her life in hospice. He gives thanks for our continued support.

Finance Ministry Team (FMT) reported that all is going well with our finances. Since the FDIC limit is \$250,000 per entity, FMT moved some money into CDs at 4.5% (one 5-month and one 12-month) and other money into Bank of America to stay under the limit. FMT is looking for a replacement treasurer to shadow Pam Knox this year. FMT is looking into external audits.

The incoming class of Elders, Bob Brewster, Brian Herndon, Dennis Calbos, and Rebecca Silver, were successfully examined. New Elders will be installed on Jan. 7, 2024.

Session approved Covenant's Ministry Discernment Profile (MDP), as presented by the Pastor Nominating Committee.

Session approved a motion from Worship Ministry Team that guest musicians be allowed to receive donations at the Afropop Epiphany concert.

Two 30-year-old HVAC units failed at the same time and another could use repairs. Session approved a motion from Building and Grounds Ministry Team to allocate \$22k from last year's surplus & zero out this year's budget line for HVAC (around \$8000). Water heater replacement in kitchen is \$3100 and coming from pre-existing funds in B&G's budget.

Arin Lozefski has put in her 2 weeks' notice, so it will just be Asher Hill working the sound and video system now - he could use some volunteer help for holiday events etc.

We will be doing the food pantry 12/21 and 12/28 - students will be home for holidays so we need help with distribution on those days 12:30-2:30. Sign-up sheet is in Covenanter and posted on Sign-up genius if you type in kwetherington@covpresathens.com (all events are under that)

Eli Stone will eventually need a liaison for his eagle scout award.
