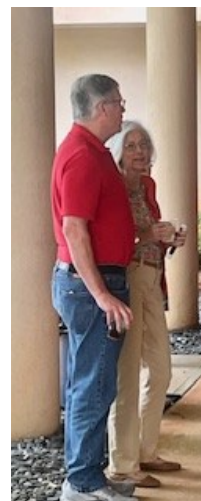
FISCAL YEAR-END

LIBRARY CORNER

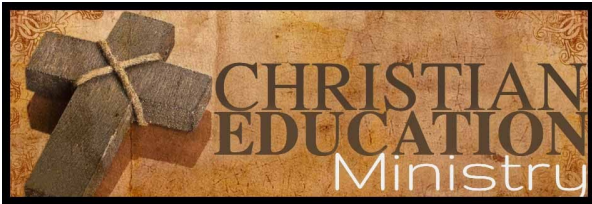
***The In-Between: Unforgettable Encounters During Life’s Final Moments* by Hadley Vlahos, RN**

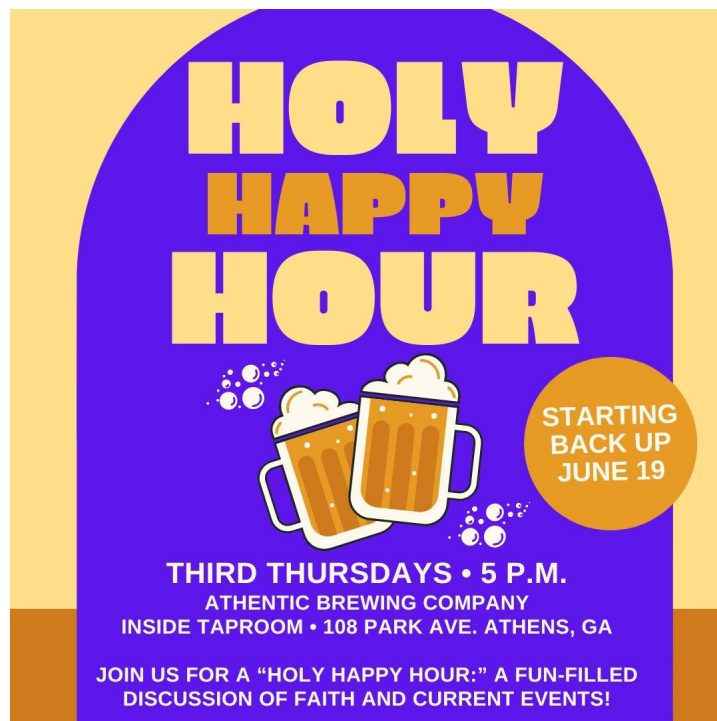
